Submission Instructions:

Abstract submissions should be no more than 600 words and include:

- Title
- Objectives (3-4 learning objectives)
- Keywords (3)
- Background
- Methods/Approach (including target population)
- Outcomes/Results
- Conclusion/Takeaways

Abstracts will be reviewed, scored, and selected by four key members of the SDIC Steering Committee.

Successful abstracts will be chosen to present either as a poster presentation or as a 15-20 minute oral presentation.



Abstract topics can include:

- Strategies to address vaccine hesitancy
- Effective communication and outreach
- Health education and promotion
- Targeted efforts for communities with low vaccine rates
- Community engagement efforts
- Building trust in clinical settings
- Research or innovative methods to improve vaccination rates
